Public Defender Matt Shirk has appointed four attorneys to the Duval County office, including one to the felony unit, one to county court duties and two to the juvenile unit.

Tiffany Poore is a former assistant public defender who is returning to the felony unit and is assigned to the office's major crime unit. Poore spent three years in the office following her 2006 graduation from Florida Coastal School of Law.

Lisa M. Gilbert is assigned to the county court unit. A 2010 graduate of Coastal School of law, Gilbert volunteered in the office and as an intern and interned in the U.S. Attorney's Office in Syracuse, N.Y.

Shannon Brooke Schott is joining the juvenile unit and is a 2010 graduate of Stetson University College of Law. Schott has worked for a civil law firm.

Chase Sorenson will also work in the juvenile unit. Sorenson is a 2010 graduate of the University of Miami School of Law.

With the four additions, the Public Defender's Office that covers Duval, Clay and Nassau counties will have 75 attorneys, said spokesman Matt Bisbee.
